The Park Ridge, Ill.-based Urban and Regional Information Systems Association (URISA) GISCorps launched its new Web site, which includes information about the history of GISCorps, strategic and operational plans, a volunteer application form and contribution opportunities.

GISCorps is a volunteer-based GIS professional entity to provide short-

term GIS expertise to less-developed countries and communities worldwide. Although assistance may be offered in the United States and Canada, the focus will remain on communities in developing countries.

GISCorps volunteers will provide GIS expertise in areas such as humanitarian relief, environmental analysis, sustainable development, economic development, community planning and development, aboriginal issues, and health- and education-related applications.

In October 2003, the URISA Board of Directors unanimously endorsed GISCorps as an initiative under URISA's auspices. Following the endorsement, a Core Committee
